A concept note for development of the compendium of ancient Indian Educational thoughts in Sanskrit.

Present educational scenario of India is primarily based on the design that British India had established a couple of centuries ago. Time to time there has been modifications keeping in view the global changes and local needs. Today, with modern educational setup, India has kept the pace with global demands and youth of India has got a sizeable place in the world's job market. With English Language and modern subjects in education we can see many positive changes like democratization of education, social and gender equity, technological advancement of the country etc. But what we are missing here is the genius of India. We have lost the spirit of innovation in the knowledge world what others would aspire to follow; rather we are just following what the western world is doing. Reasons may be many, but the root lies somewhere that we have alienated ourselves from our indigenous knowledge, traditions and practices. Today, if we enquire about our knowledge tradition, we find innumerable names of scholars cutting across all areas of knowledge, be it science, literature or philosophy whose works still hold relevance in present times.

It makes sense to note that in the last couple of centuries Indian indigenous knowledge system has been altered completely with introduction of western educational system and hence forth India has almost stopped producing genius. Growth of our Shastric traditions has been obstructed and many traditions have been extinct. We have departed from our tradition so much that now we don't have a clear picture of Indian educational system in our sight. A few disciplines like philosophy, linguistics and literature (Vedic and Classical) are left with us for traditional studies. But some of our traditional texts hint about our far wider and richer education including various sciences, art, agriculture, commerce etc. prevalent in ancient and medieval India.

Today, we have complete treatises on many disciplines like various darshana shastras, grammar, poetics, dharmashastras, logic etc. But we don't have a dedicated shastra on education available, whereas imprints of educational thoughts are noticed here and there in various literatures and shastras. There is no doubt that a robust educational system was prevalent in India for centuries, other wise our ancestors could not have produced geniuses like. Panini, Kanada, Shankara, Arya-Bhatta, Bhaskara, Charaka, Vyasa, Valmiki, Kalidasa and so on and so forth. Though we have treasured innumerable names and works of those geniuses, we don't have any anecdotal records of their making. Now we have the end products of those brilliant minds but we don't know the process of developing those minds. We just often tag some legends of divine intervention or miracles to the life of those legendary human beings.

So it's worthwhile to dig deep into our history to find out any doctrine of education which ruled our golden past and take some cues from there to give an alternative to the present educational system. With this in mind, we have proposed a research cum developmental project titled as “A compendium of ancient Indian educational thoughts in Sanskrit (संस्कृत शिक्षा सन्दर्भ कोष) where in we aim to collect all references of

educational doctrines from various literatures like Vedas, Upanishads, Ramayana, Mahabharata, Puranas, grammar and other literatures in Sanskrit. The collected references can be categorised into various areas of education like educational philosophy, Psychology, teaching methodologies, educational administration, special education, early childhood education etc. Prudent Scholars from various specialization like Vedic literature, Grammar, Classical literature, Dharmashastra, Darshana Shastras etc. are humbly requested to research their fields to find all materials related to education and make this compendium useful for students, teachers educators, researchers and general learners who have interest in Indic studies.
