The 3rd meeting of the Research Committee of Shree Somnath Sanskrit University, Veraval was held on 02-08-2019 at 11:00 am in the Conference Room of the University. Present,

First of all the Chairperson extended a warm welcome to the members of research committee of Shree Somnath Sanskrit University, Veraval. The works done in accordance with the recommendations made in the previous meeting were ratified/ approved. Thereafter, the following matters were transacted.

- 1. The Research Committee ratified/approved all the works done by the Research Section as recommended from Sr. No. 1 to 05 in the meeting of 09-10-2018.
- 2. The Research Committee recommends the following syllabus for MET (M.Phil. Entrance Test) of 50 Marks for 50 Questions as per the latest UGC NET syllabus for Paper-2 of Sanskrit (Code-25) updated in 2019. The recommended syllabus for MET from the academic year 2020-2021 will be Five (05) Units as from the latest UGC NET syllabus for Paper-2 of Sanskrit (Code-25) updated in 2019. Note: 10 Questions of 10 Marks will be asked from all the Five (05) Units of the syllabus. In Unit-1, 3 Questions from Jyotishshastra will be asked out of 10 Questions.
 - Unit-1 = वेद-वेदाङ्गसाहित्यस्य सामान्यपरिचयः (Unit-1 of UOC NET Syllabus)
 - Unit-2 = दर्शनसाहित्यस्य सामान्यपरिचयः (Unit-3 of UGC NET Syllabus)
 - Unit-3 = व्याकरणस्य भाषाविज्ञानस्य च सामान्यपरिचयः (Unit-5 of UGC NET Syllabus)
 - Unit-4 = संस्कृतसाहित्यस्य काव्यशास्त्रस्य छन्दसः च सामान्यपरिचयः (Unit-7 of UGC NET Syllabus)
 - Unit-5 = पुराणेतिहासस्य, धर्मशास्त्रस्य अभिलेखशास्त्रस्य च सामान्यपरिचयः (Unit-9 of UGC NET Syllabus)
- 3. The Research Committee recommends to charge Rs. 200 /- (Two Hundred Rs. Only) as MET (M.Phil. Entrance Test) Fee from the academic year 2020-21.
- 4. The Research Committee recommends implementing online registration of MET (M.Phil. Entrance Test) Application Form from the academic year 2020-21.
- 5. The Research Committee recommends the updated syllabus for PET (Ph.D. Entrance Test) as per the latest UGC NET syllabus for Paper-1 (General) and Paper-2 (Sanskrit with Code-25) updated in 2019 as under:

 - Unit-1 = Teaching Aptitude
 - Unit-2 = Research Aptitude
 - Unit-3 = Comprehension

9. The Research Committee recommends organizing Orientation Programme for the Academic Staff of the University on "Procurement of Research Projects from different agencies like RSS, New Delhi; ICSSR, New Delhi; ICPR, New Delhi; ICHR, New Delhi; ICR, New Delhi and Others."

10. The Research Committee recommends procuring Six Monthly Progress Reports of all Ph.D. Scholars manually.

11. The Research Committee recommends to issue Smart ID Cards to M.Phil./Ph.D. candidates with one year validity to M.Phil. candidates and two years validity to Ph.D. candidates.

12. The Research Committee recommends conducting the M.Phil. Viva-Voce Examination of a candidate in the presence of his/her research supervisor (Guide) and one expert strictly as per the SSSU Regulations.

13. The Research Committee recommends amendments in M.Phil. Dissertation / Ph.D. Thesis Submission Form as under:

• Implementation of Plagiarism Act.

• Plagiarism Report to be taken from the Librarian in percentage (%) both in M.Phil./Ph.D. Submission Form.

• All CD/DVD of M.Phil. Dissertation / Ph.D. Thesis to be physically verified and certified by the Librarian as per the UGC/INFLIBNET Regulations.

• M.Phil. enrolment number is to be mentioned mandatorily by the candidate in the M.Phil. Dissertation Submission Form

 Notifications/Results of paper number 1, 2 and 3 of M.Phil. Course are to be attached in the M.Phil. Dissertation Submission Form by the candidate

• Ph.D. registration number and date are to be mentioned mandatorily by the candidate in the Ph.D. Thesis Submission Form

- 17. The Research Committee recommends purchasing OMR Software/OMR Sheet Reader/Printer for MET, PET and other examinations of the University.
- 18. Suggestion by Dr. Dipesh Vinod Katira: 31st July will be the last date for submission of M.Phil. Dissertation every year. The Research Committee solemnly recommends the same.
- 19. Suggestion by Dr. Dipesh Vinod Katira: MET (M.Phil. Entrance Test) should be conducted in the month of July every year, whereas PET (Ph.D. Entrance Test) should be conducted in the month of August every year. The Research Committee solemnly recommends the same.
- 20. Suggestion by Chairperson: Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Gopabandhu Sir suggested that the Written (Subjective) Test of all NET/SET/PET qualified candidates & M.Phil. Degree Holders be conducted after PET and before Ph.D. Course Work. The Written (Subjective) Test of all NET/SET/PET qualified candidates & M.Phil. Degree Holders would be of hundred (100) marks as under:

Part-1 = Subject/Specialization Test = 25 Marks

Part-2 = Translation Test = 25 Marks

Part-3 = Research Test = 50 Marks Total = 100 Marks

21. Suggestion by Chairperson: Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Gopabandhu Sir suggested to extend the validity of PET Certificate from existing two (2) years three (3) years.
